Dr. Meyer is a practicing Emergency Physician at Kaiser Permanente San Diego Medical Center.

He is currently the regional simulation physician director for Kaiser Permanente Southern California.

His focus is the creation of broad-based simulation programs that include formal simulation instructor training, standardized simulation curriculums that include standardized measurement tools, and simulation-based medical research.

Most recently Dr. Meyer has developed a risk analysis model and process that allows for creation of simulation curricula based upon risk mitigation and will better demonstrate ROI for simulation programs.

Through collaboration with risk, quality, and patient safety, he is working to address the challenges of large-scale implementation and maintenance of programs designed for practicing professional staff, while demonstrating new applications for simulation that can demonstrate clear value to both our patients and our medical leadership.

In addition, Dr. Meyer is currently working with the American Heart Association to develop simulation-based resuscitation courses. This includes specialty-specific ACLS, PALS, and BLS courses.
